The Institute

The institute is formed with the purpose of offering the serious young Pianist a unique opportunity to work with outstanding teachers and acclaimed guest artists in an intensive and varied program.

Course of Study

Private Lessons

Two individual lessons per week of forty-five to sixty minutes each (solo and concerto literature).

Group Classes

Daily classes feature a variety of programs: Workshops for the elementary students. Eurhythmics and choral singing. Master Classes for the advanced pianists. Selected student performances with discussion among peers and teachers. Piano Pedagogy Classes for teachers.

Ensemble Music

Study of piano duet or duo piano literature, weekly coaching and opportunities to perform ensemble music in recital.

Supervised Practice

Regular practice periods by experienced teachers and assistants are available to help students work productively.

Master Classes

A hearing to select performers for the master classes will take place for participants wishing to be considered for this honour. The audition will consist of a work from the standard repertoire that has been memorised and polished.

Pre Camp (Prep for the Intensive Program)

Teaching of fundamental techniques for the elementary pianists. Course study includes: private lessons, supervised practices, piano workshops, masterclasses, choir. **REQUIRES** schedule flexibility, PM sessions only.

Repertoire to prepare

All prospective students should bring at least three pieces for study: one thoroughly perfected and two in the refining stage.

Additional Features

Performances: Performance opportunities include weekly concerts featuring piano participants.

Distinguished Artists

Eleanor Wong: A.R.A.M., G.R.S.M., L.R.A.M., A.R.C.M., Recital Dip. (R.A.M.) Postgraduate Dip. (Manhattan School of Music, New York)

Ms. Wong is Artist in Residence at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts, The Chinese University of Hong Kong and is a regular visiting teacher to Shenzhen School of Arts. Her students have won many national and international competitions. As a performer, Ms. Wong has concertized in England, United States, China and Hong Kong. Ms. Wong is an active adjudicator and lecturer and has given Master Classes in Beijing and Sichuan. She is the chairman of The Hong Kong Piano Teachers Association. Her teachers have included Arthur Balsam and Vlado Perlemuter.

Helen Wong: M.Mus., University of Michigan, A.R.A.M., L.R.S.M.

Ms. Wong was on the piano faculty of The Hong Kong Academy of Performing Arts before joining The San Francisco Conservatory of Music and The Menuhin faculty at the Nueva School in Hillsborough, California. Ms. Wong is an active performer, adjudicator and lecturer. She has concertized in the U.K., U.S.A., China and Hong Kong. She has given lectures and Master Classes in Sichuan and Beijing. Her teachers have included Max Pirani and Gyorgy Sander.

Mary Yeung: M. Mus. Ed., HK Baptist University

Mary Yeung began her early piano training with Josephine Lo and Wong Tak Lun. Graduating with a B. A. degree in Music at the Chinese University of HK under Choi Sown Li in 1987, Mary studied choral conducting under Dr. Angela Tam while teaching Music at Canossa College. In 1996, Mary became Panel head of the Music department while completing her Master degree in Mus. Ed. at HK Baptist University. At Canossa College, Mary started instrumental classes, orchestras and school choirs that participated in local competitions and events. These groups served as an excellent platform for nurturing young music lovers.

Nancy Loo: M.Mus., The Juilliard School

Ms. Loo has won numerous international competitions, including the ðRina Sala Galloí, ðMarguerite Longí, ðViottif and the ðPremio Jaení. Her teachers have included Adele Marcus, Vlado Perlemuter and Guido Agosti. An active performer, she has given recitals in Europe, North America, East Asia and Hong Kong. Ms. Loo is on the faculty of The Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts, University of Hong Kong, Baptist University and Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Li Ming Qiang

Internationally known recording artist, concert pianist, teacher and competition judge. Prof Li has concertized extensively throughout the world, and performed with major orchestras. He has recorded works of many composers including Bach, Beethoven, Brahms, Chopin, Liszt, Mozart, Rachmaninov and Schubert. In recent years, Prof. Li has been lecturing and giving master classes around the world.

Mary Mei-Loc Wu: A.R.C.M.(Hons), M.Mus.,D.M.A.

Giving her first public appearance at the age of three, she has benefited from numerous teachers including her mother Constance Wu, Betty Drown, Peter Norris, Louis Kentner, Kendall Taylor, Phyllis Sellick, Ruth Dysan, Vlado Perlemuter and Gilbert Kalish. Perlemuter called her "one of the most gifted pianists of her generation". Ms. Wu is on the faculty of The Hong Kong Academy of Performing Arts, and the Music Department, Chinese University of Hong Kong.

2) **Pre-camp:** \$23,000 per course.

學院宗旨

本院宗旨在培養年青而有意志於鋼琴演奏的音樂學生由資深而知名的導師進行嚴格及多元化訓練。

課程

個別教授：每週兩次，每次授課四十五分鐘至一小時，以獨奏及協奏曲目為主。

組別教授：每日分組教授包括

- 初學入門訓練
- 高級學生參研大師班
- 個別演奏及演繹研討
- 鋼琴教學法

合奏訓練：每週有雙人鋼琴或雙人鋼琴合奏之訓練及合奏演出之機會。

指導練習：由有經驗的鋼琴教師及高級學員作經常性的指導練習，增加學生的學習成效。

大師班

優異學生將由導師聆聽學生背奏一首熟習之樂曲。

樂韻預備班

教授基本鋼琴技巧，學習科目包括：私人授課、提導練習、參與：演繹研討、大師班、歌詠班、下午授課、上課時間須具彈性。

樂曲準備：學生須至少準備一首已熟習和兩首學習中之樂曲。

其他項目：每週之演奏將給予學生演奏機會。

導師

黃懿倫：現任香港演藝學院駐院藝術家亦任教於香港中文大學，及深圳藝術學院，並任香港鋼琴教師協會主席。黃女仕曾多次在中，英，美，及本港演奏，講學，及作音樂比賽評判。黃女仕的學生曾多次在本港及國際鋼琴比賽中奪魁。黃女仕早年畢業於英國皇家音樂學院，後師巴爾森及拉菲爾之高徒柏爾梅特。

黃慰倫：早年曾任教於香港演藝學院，現任美國加州三藩市音樂學院及紐華書院曼紐軒音樂課程導師。黃女仕曾多次在中，英，美，港演奏及講學，亦多次擔任鋼琴比賽裁判，包括加州巴托克音樂節。黃女仕畢業於英國皇家音樂學院，後獲美國密西根大學音樂碩士，其間從師派拉尼及巴托克之高徒山特。

楊漱瑩：早年跟隨羅美琪和黃德倫修習鋼琴，後獲中文大學音樂學士。任教音樂于嘉諾撒書院，同時跟隨譚靜芝學習合唱指揮。九六年，出任嘉諾撒書院音樂科主任，同年完成浸會大學音樂教育碩士。在嘉諾撒書院任教期間，積極培養校園音樂氛圍：開辦樂器班，組中、西樂團，並發展合唱團，成立培養年輕音樂愛好者的良好平台。

大師班客串導師

羅乃新：早年獲紐約茱莉亞音樂學院獎金，隨名師聰斯，獲該校碩士，後師侍貝利慕特及阿哥斯提於巴黎和意大利，屢獲國際獎。羅氏是一活躍的演奏家，曾在歐美及東南亞多國舉行獨奏和管弦樂團合奏。羅氏任教於香港演藝學院，香港大學，中文大學及浸會大學，並在港四台擔任樂曲介紹工作。

李名強：世界聞名的鋼琴演奏家，教師，及國際鋼琴比賽評委。獲得多項國際鋼琴獎。曾應邀在世界各地舉行鋼琴獨奏會並與其主要交響樂團一起演出。唱片錄音包括巴哈，貝多芬，布拉姆斯，蕭邦等。近年來，一直在世界各地講學及主持大師班。

吳美樂：吳氏是一位出色的獨奏家，足跡遍及世界多個著名音樂廳，曾與多個著名交響樂團合作演出。吳女士獲多位名師悉心培育：其母吳黃瑞貞、杜爾夫人、羅諾士、簡拿史歷、戴臣、簡度泰拿、柏行慕建及加里殊。吳氏現任教於香港演藝學院，中文大學音樂學院。吳氏畢業於英國皇家音樂學院。並在紐約州立大學取得博士學位。
